## SMOKE TESTING IN KENMORE

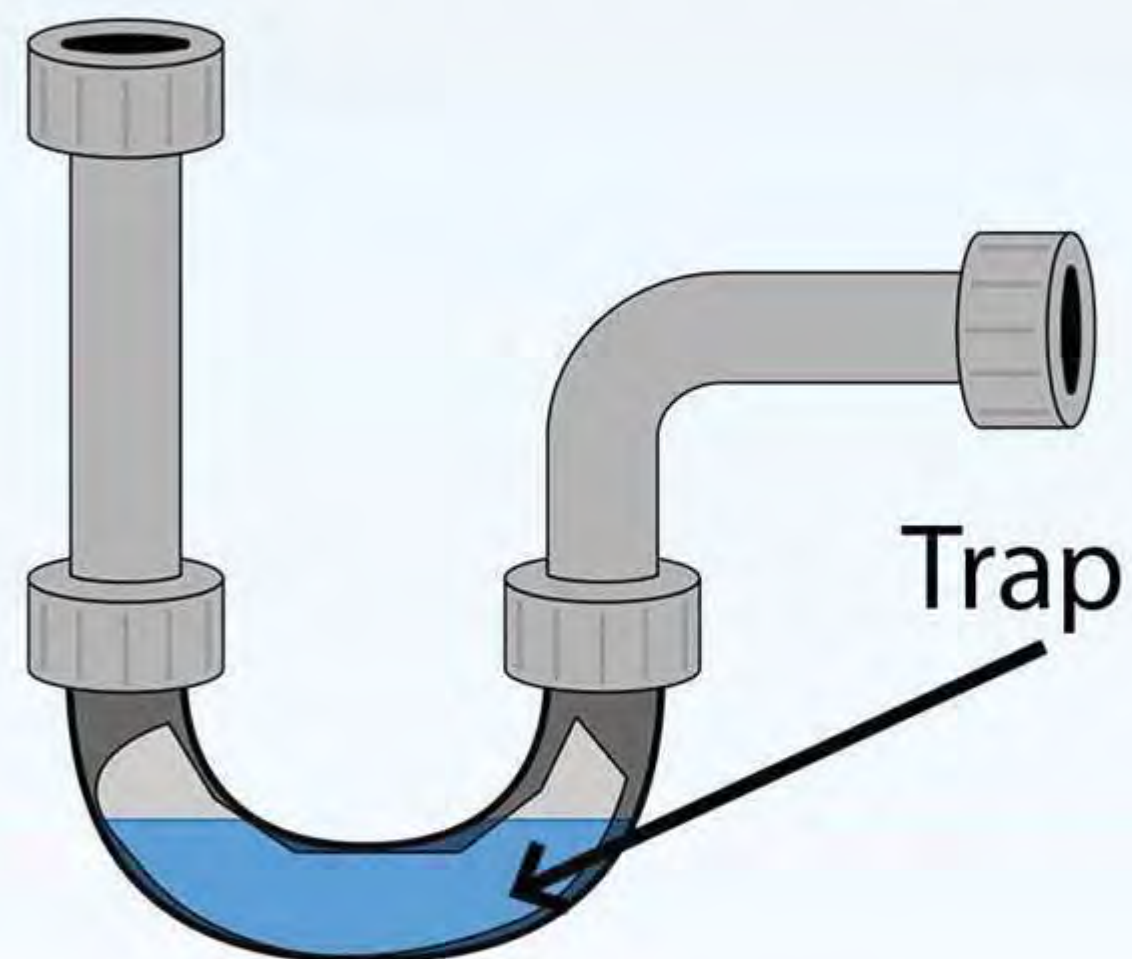
We do smoke testing to find breaks and defects in the sewer system, as well as places where storm and other surface waters are entering sanitary sewers.

## THINGS TO KNOW

1. **The smoke is not harmful.** It may make you cough, but it will not harm your health or clothing.
2. **To avoid getting smoke inside your home/business...** check to see that all traps under basins, washing facilities and floor drains have water in them. If you can't tell, *pour a gallon of water into the drain.*
3. **If the smoke gets into your home/business...** Contact the crew working in the area. Open windows for ventilation.
4. **Smoke will not "stop up" the sewers.**



*A filled trap should prevent smoke from entering your house.*
